
Mission Statement

Today is a shorter service with a relaxed feel, so please grab a drink and find a table. The children stay with us this morning as we worship together and think about Jesus and the bible.

Children and Holy Communion – Here is a brief update about where we are on this matter:

The WPCC took the decision on July 8 2014 that as a parish we would move towards allowing children to receive Holy Communion (after a suitable introduction and teaching sessions, and when each child is ready to take this step.)

At the last WPCC meeting on Sep 22, Jane Tibbs (Children, Families and Early Years Adviser for Diocese of Bath & Wells) gave a presentation about how to introduce children to communion, and took questions from the PCC. The clergy on the staff team are now working on the final details and it is hoped that we can begin the lessons for children early next year. For more details speak to Revd Chris.

Link Team update – Revd Chris took an assembly last Wednesday morning all about the Good Samaritan. Gill & Sharon were also present – building relationships and getting to know the staff. Chris' next assembly is November 25. Please pray for our relationship with the school, and if you have any ideas about how we can serve the school and it's community, please speak to either Gill, Sharon or Revd Chris.
