Three Peaks update

Rev Chris took an assembly last Wednesday to show the school children the photos of the challenge, and to relate it all to one of the five school values—perseverance. It was a lovely time and the children were really engaged and asking questions. Mrs Bath, the Head Teacher, awarded all five team members a special 'Headteacher's Award', which is a metal lapel badge. This was a rare honour because normally it is given to children only. In fact we were the first adults to receive this from Mrs Bath. The children gave a standing ovation also, which was fantastic.

So far, about £1200 has been raised through the website and around £1100 through school sponsorship. There is also several hundred pounds from team members' sponsorship—so around £2500 (estimated) from which we can deduct £446 for the costs and then divide by two between school and church. We thank God for such a successful challenge and the continuing boost to our great relationship with the school. Thank you again for all your support and prayers.
